Subject : The antitrust case which the Company was alleged in Australia

To : President,
The Stock Exchange of Thailand

Thai Airways International Public Company Limited would like to inform that, with respect to the investigation by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC), on 28 October 2009, the ACCC has subsequently filed a lawsuit against the Company for violating Trade Practices Act 1974 without the amount of fines and expenses having been specified. After that, on 14 December 2012, the court in Australia rendered a judgment pursuant to the settlement made between the Company and the ACCC. The court permitted the Company to pay the pecuniary penalty of AUD 7.5 million to the Commonwealth of Australia and pay for the ACCC's costs to these proceedings in the sum of AUD 500,000. Such pecuniary penalty can be paid in 7 installments during a period of 3 years. The amount of this fine penalty has already been covered by the reserve made by the Company.
